## MCPS POST-COVID INCLEMENT WEATHER PLAN

When inclement weather is forecast or actively occurring–

- the Department of Transportation (DOT) will monitor the forecast and actual roadway conditions,
- the Department of Facilities Management (DFM) will monitor school sites and buildings, and
- after considering recommendations from DOT and DFM, the Office of Operations (OPS) will make a recommendation to the Superintendent for a final decision on any changes to normal school system operations.

Option Overview	This option will include minor weather events that are deemed not significant enough to close the building for staff, but that impact safe transportation to school for students. The option to switch to or continue virtual learning allows MCPS to make the decision and provide notification to families and staff much earlier than previously, without the concern of having to make up a day of instruction at the end of the school year.	This option will include weather events that may have closed school in years past. Like the <i>Virtual Instruction- Buildings</i> <i>Open</i> option, all instruction will be delivered virtually, resulting in an approved academic day.	This option reflects severe conditions that require schools and offices be closed. This decision may be implemented at times of extreme weather events, or widespread internet or power outages when virtual instruction is not feasible or challenging to support. These days will use inclement weather days built into the academic calendar if available, and potentially need to be made up at the end of the school year.	This option would be implemented when an unexpected weather event occurs while students may be in school buildings (small groups, hybrid, appointments and assessments, etc.). During an early closing, instruction would end early (2.5 hours) for all students, including those learning virtually.
