Summer School Offerings

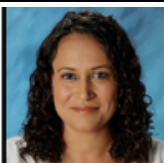

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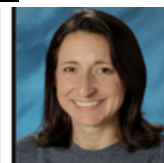

Congratulations, National Merit Finalists!

A huge congratulations to our three National Merit Scholarship Finalists Charlotte Martin, Emma Doyle, and Sanjay Tan! These students are among the top 1% of U.S. high school seniors, recognized for exceptional academic performance on the PSAT/NMSQT, high grades, and leadership. It is an elite status, with about 15,000–16,000 students advancing from semifinalist to finalist. Only about half of the 16,000 semifinalists become finalists, representing the highest level of academic accomplishment.

For next steps, a selection committee will select the National Merit Scholars based on academic records, essays, and school recommendations. At that point, the National Merit Scholars may compete for corporate scholarships, college-sponsored scholarships, or a \$2,500 National Merit Scholarship.
