Message from the Cambridge Lead Teacher

Greetings,

I will be meeting with all AICE classes prior to the start of the June 2022 Cambridge Exam Series on Monday, April 25th. The following items are of the utmost importance and will be emphasized to students during these meetings:

Morning exams start at 9 AM and afternoon exams start at 1 PM. All students must arrive 45 minutes prior to the start of the exam. This means for morning exams the arrival time is 8:15 AM. For afternoon exams, the arrival time is 12:15 PM. All exams, except the Biology and Chemistry practical components, will be taken in G Wing. There are no make-up exams for Cambridge so late arrivals will not be able to sit for the exam.

- There is no reason for students to bring anything with them to the exam. All backpacks, cell phones, smart watches, and any other unauthorized items will need to be collected prior to entering the exam room. Having to collect these items from a large group of students is time consuming. All materials needed for the exam will be provided.

Cambridge International at AHS- Parent Information Night



Highlighting Cambridge Classrooms-Marine Science

Mr. Carpenter's AICE Marine Science students took a field trip the ACE Basin National Wildlife Refuge and I was lucky enough to get an invite to chaperone. Throughout the school year, students in AS Marine Science have learned about the makeup of ocean and the interrelationship of organisms. On March 29th, the classes had a opportunity to travel to Bennett's Point SC to the SCDNR McKenzie field station. At the field station the students went on an hour and forty-five minutes boat ride in the estuary. The students tested the water's salinity, PH level, turbidity, dissolved oxygen, and air temperature. The crew also dropped a net the crew. Once the students were back on land, they dissected squid. 
