In A Heartbeat, a CT based nonprofit organization, will be providing free cardiac screenings (EKG's) on Thursday April 3 from 3pm-7pm at Ridgefield High School (Student Center). CLICK HERE to learn more about In A Heartbeat. EKG screenings can detect many (although not all) heart conditions which if untreated can lead to sudden cardiac arrest. If detected, the goal is to get them treated and get kids back to their lives. The 14 point screener and EKG can identify risk factors of sudden cardiac arrest (SCA). The event will be staffed with volunteer technicians who answer any questions you may have. Parents will receive EKG results from "In A Heartbeat" within two weeks.
