With the recent COVID-19 pandemic, the Orangevale-Fair Oaks Food Bank expects to see an increase of up to 5x the typical demand in the coming months. Pre-COVID-19 we would serve approximately 1,200 people per month. 6-8 weeks into the pandemic we are serving almost 3,000 people per month and we expect our numbers to rise up to 6,000 people per month in the weeks and months ahead.
