

# 2023–2024 Exam Fee Financial Assistance Form

Students qualifying for testing fee reductions receive a discount for PSAT, SAT, Advanced Placement (AP) and International Baccalaureate (IB) exam fees. Fee waivers are not guaranteed. Financial assistance is granted on a case by case basis; additional CCSD fee waivers may be available. Enrollment at a Community Eligible Provision school does not guarantee fee reductions for testing. All CCD students must complete this form annually.

Students who meet one or more of the guidelines listed on page 2 are eligible. Please complete required information in Section I and Section II to be considered for a fee reduction for PSAT, SAT, AP and IB exam fees

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## Section I: Student Eligibility Information

Students are eligible for exam fee reductions on PSAT/NMSQT, SAT, AP, and IB exams they take in a given year if they meet any of the following criteria (please check any that apply):

- The student meets one or more of the following criteria:**
  - The student is enrolled in a federal, state, or local program that aids students from low-income families (e.g., Federal TRIO programs such as Upward Bound).
  - The student's family receives public assistance.
  - The student is a member of a family whose annual income falls within the Income Eligibility Guidelines set by the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) Food and Nutrition Service (see the USDA Income Eligibility Table on page 2).
  - The student is in a household participating in the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF), the Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservations (FDPIR), or Medicaid Benefits.
  - The student lives in federally subsidized public housing or a foster home.
  - The student is homeless, migrant, runaway, or in foster care.
  - The student is a ward of the state or an orphan.
  - The student is enrolled in a federally funded Head Start Program.
  
- The student has status as a legally emancipated minor or, in the best judgment of the school testing coordinator, is entirely responsible for his/own support and may also have qualified for waiver of other school-related fees such as athletics, program, or arts participation.**
