

## Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) All Schools

The district is expanding the CEP program to include all schools. This allows all students to receive free meals without completing a free/reduced application.

However, districts still need to collect and report low-income data to the state to receive funds from the Learning Assistance Program (LAP) grant. The district uses a simple income survey to collect information from families. There are two methods for completing the survey...

- Online via Parent Portal. Families that complete the Annual Information Update are prompted with the income survey questions (pic below). This is the preferred method. Surveys completed in the Parent Portal automatically flow to the CEP report tool.
  - o \*Families new to Pasco are prompted to complete the income survey during the online registration process

El distrito utiliza una encuesta de ingresos simple para recopilar información de las familias. Hay dos métodos para completar la encuesta...

- En línea a través del Portal para Padres. Las familias que completan la Actualización Anual de Información reciben las preguntas de la encuesta de ingresos (imagen de abajo). Este es el método preferido. Las encuestas completadas en el Portal para Padres fluyen automáticamente a la herramienta de reportes CEP.
