- The University School Office will remain open through Tuesday, May 31st. Our hours are 9:00 AM - 3:30 PM. The office will be closed June 1st-July 18th. The office will reopen on Tuesday, July 19th for families to contact.
- The first student day of the 2022-2023 school year will be Wednesday, August 3rd. Please note that our school day will be pushed back by 30 minutes. Our instructional day will run from 9:30 AM - 4:15 PM. (Buses unload at 9:15 AM and load at 4:00 PM).

- 5. We do have a few items in the front entry of the school that belong to students. If your child is missing something, you are welcome to come by the front entry to check prior to May 31st.

- <u>The Free Breakfast/Lunch Program will NOT continue for the 2022-2023 school</u> <u>year.</u> Students will be charged for breakfast and lunch. It is important that you fill out the appropriate Free/Reduced application forms during the enrollment process if you need to take advantage of free/reduced breakfast/lunch/textbooks.
- During the 4th quarter, students in grades K-6 focused on a new unit of inquiry through their special area classes on "play." Students explored how, "People express themselves through play," part of the unit, *How We Express Ourselves*. Last year, you may remember that your children engaged in a Question Museum. - 10. Per Indiana Department of Education, we are required to notify our families regarding llearn rescores. Please be aware that we have not received all the completed scores as of yet. parents and schools must have an opportunity to review and/or request a rescore for any eligible open-ended item(s) which students responded to on the ILEARN assessment. If you are interested in participating in this process, you must make arrangements to visit our school to view your student's responses to any open-ended ILEARN items and request any rescores. If you are on a transfer to University School this year, it is MCCSC policy that you submit a new transfer request for the 2022-2023 school year. <u>Inner School Transfer Request</u> <u>Out of District Transfer Request</u> Inner School Transfer Requests must start at your child's home school. Transfer requests are dependent on enrollment.
- 13. Virtual Summer Camp is an easy way for your child to stay sharp this summer from the comfort of your own home. This program is available to students currently in K through 8th grades. Your child can log on at any point throughout the week to complete these assignments or work on their personalized learning path in reading and/or math.
