

Hiram High School Intercession Program

What is Intercession?

Hiram High School Intercession is a course extension option for students who failed a class with a final grade of 60 - 69 during the 2021-2022 school year. Intercession will be held @ P.B. Ritch Middle School due to Summer Construction on Hiram HS campus.

How does it work?

- Only students with a final grade of 60-69 can participate. **NO EXCEPTIONS**!
- The student will be enrolled in 5 extra days of class (20 hours total).
- F2F attendance is Mandatory. A virtual Check-in with students will be done daily. Teachers will send communication.
- Intercession is a hybrid instructional opportunity with teachers monitoring student progress. The student must earn full credit of **ALL** assigned modules. If the student is successful, then the final grade for the course will be replaced with a passing grade of a 70, earning credit for the course.
- Students must be picked up by 1:00 pm or student will not be allowed to continue in this program.
- No Cell Phones, Earbuds/Headphones allowed during the sessions. All school rules apply, and students will need paper & pencil.
- Violations of school / Intercession rules will result in the removal of the student from the Credit Repair opportunity.
- All work will need to be completed by last day course intercession is offered!
