
Please follow the instructions below to sign up for VIRTUAL conferences on Tuesday. Appointments are not needed for IN PERSON on Wednesday.

- The scheduler, pickAtime https://pickatime.com/GraniteSD/CottonwoodHS, will be available UNTIL Monday, February 7 at 11:59 p.m.
- We have created 5-minute time slots. Parents will be put into a "waiting room" on the Zoom call and teachers will admit parents/guardians into their zoom meeting as close to the appointed time as possible.
- Please, help teachers stay on schedule and keep your discussion less than 5 minutes so that the teacher, and you can move to your next appointment.
