Dear Estes Park families, staff, and students:

The Larimer County Department of Health and Environment has learned that someone at Estes Park School has been diagnosed with COVID-19.

We have identified you (or your child if under 18) as someone who was potentially exposed to COVID-19 on one or more of the following dates: August 30th. If you choose to quarantine, please follow these [quarantine guidelines](#) from the Larimer County website.

Please monitor for [symptoms](#) for 14 days past the exposure, even if those symptoms seem minor. If you develop any [symptoms](#) consistent with COVID-19 during this time:

- Follow [isolation guidelines](#)
- Stay home from work/school and avoid other activities around other people
- Seek medical care and [testing](#) for COVID-19; call your doctor before you show up

If you choose to get tested for COVID-19 without symptoms, know that it can take up to 14 days after exposure to test positive or develop symptoms. A negative test result does not mean that you (or your child) will not develop symptoms or become positive after the test.

The Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment also strongly recommends that people who were potentially exposed to COVID-19 do the following for 14 days after an exposure:

- Wear a mask and stay at least 6ft from others
- Wash hands regularly, avoid crowds, and take other precautions to prevent the spread of COVID-19
- Avoid contact with [high-risk individuals](#)
