### FLU SEASON REMINDERS!



Typical flu symptoms (You don't have to have all the following S/Sx to have the flu)

| <b>Congestion</b>     | <b>Headache</b>          |
| <b>Chills</b>         | <b>Fatigue</b>           |
| <b>Fever over 101</b> | <b>Muscle/body aches</b> |

Did you know that you **cannot** get the flu from the flu vaccine?

4 Ways to reduce your flu risk:

1. Get your flu vaccine (early)
2. Wash your hands frequently
3. Get prompt medical attention if you develop flu symptoms (Tamiflu is MOST effective if given within 2 days of experiencing symptoms)
4. **Keep your distance if you are sick or if you are around someone that is sick**

If you are experiencing flu symptoms, please **DO NOT** come to school! YCSD policy is you must be fever free for 24 hours without the aid of medication (Tylenol, Advil, etc) before you can return. Returning to school while still symptomatic spreads the virus and exposes others to the flu virus! **PLEASE BE KIND, AND STAY HOME UNTIL SYMPTOM FREE!**

# York County School Division Community Service Program

The York County School Division recognizes students who perform 150 or more hours of community service during grades 9-12. Students who transfer into the York County School Division the summer before or anytime during grades 10-12 will be required to complete a prorated number of hours.

Community service activities are those activities that students perform to benefit at least one other unrelated person for which they receive no compensation or academic credit. Students will work under the auspices of an organization, government, school, non-profit, hospital, nursing home, religious organization, or shelter. Services to benefit for profit businesses will not be applied to this requirement. Students who successfully complete the Community Service Program are recognized with the Community Service Seal on their diplomas.

Hours earned as part of the Community Service Program must be documented on the Community Service Log and turned in to your counselor and no later than April 15<sup>th</sup> of your senior year. Students are responsible for identifying a supervisor for each community service activity. Supervisors must verify earned hours by signing the Community Service Log and providing the contact information.
