Ocean View Families,

Your students have recently completed their end-of-the-year benchmark assessments. The growth our SEALS demonstrated was amazing! Teachers will be sending home results soon if they haven't already. Take a few moments to celebrate your student's academic accomplishments with them. They have worked hard.

Be sure to keep your children reading this summer. Reading to your child and having them read are both extremely valuable. Boost (reading skill program) will be available until the end of June, and iReady (math skill program) will be available until the end of July. Newly acquired skills are easily lost without practice.

Next year will look a little different at Ocean View. Our Special Education Preschool classes will be moving to Klatt Elementary, 6th grade will move to middle school, and AK Choice will be moving into five classrooms. They will occupy the rooms that 5th grade, 6th grade, and Mrs. Pool currently occupy. Ocean View is a large elementary school, and there will be room for everyone. 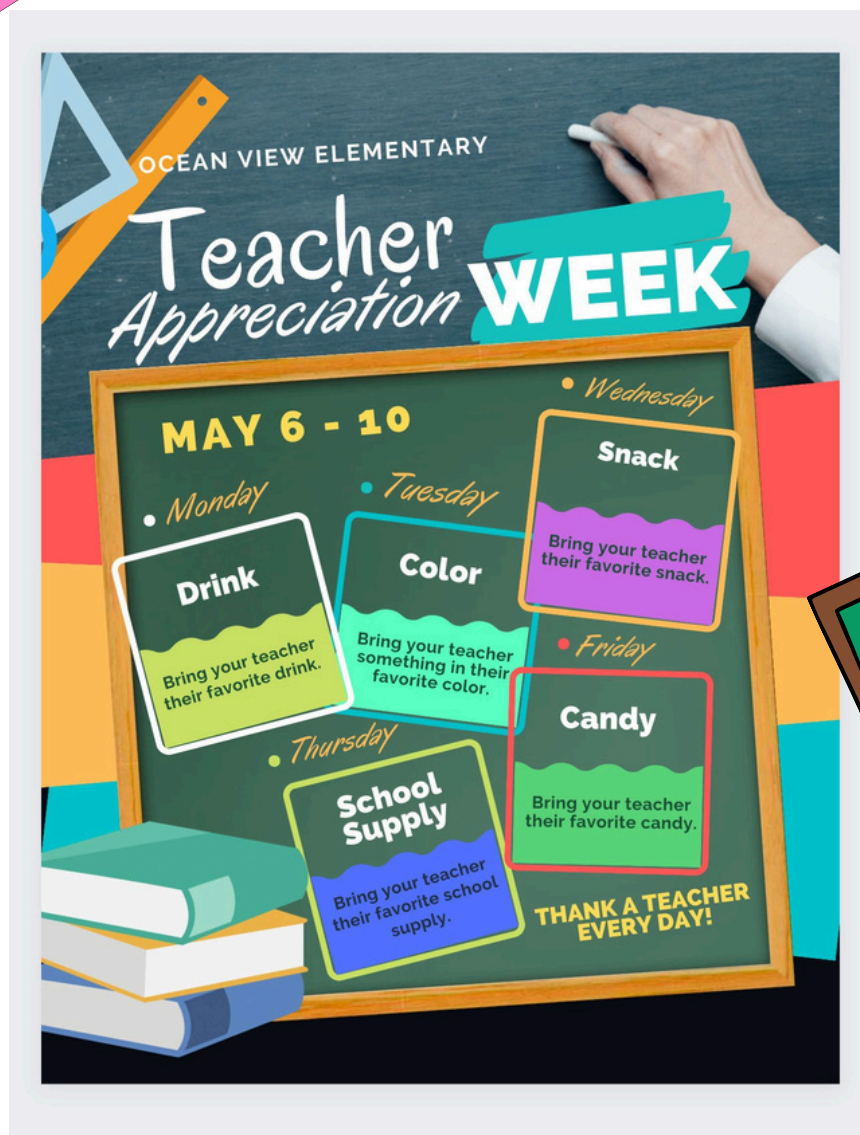

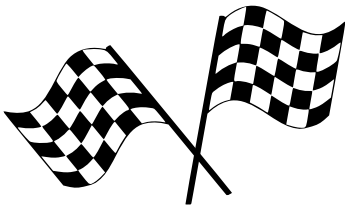
