Physicals for Student Athletes

Per AHSAA rules, each student-athlete must have an up-to-date (within one calendar year) physical to participate in school sports. On Wednesday, January 17th, Spain Park will host school physicals for Berry athletes from 3:30 - 5:00. Physicals will be completed by area physicians and the ATI staff. Physicals will cost \$20 per studentathlete. We encourage our athletes to take advantage of this opportunity because 1. It keeps all of our athletes on the same paperwork cycle 2. More convenient than going to Dr.'s office 3. This serves as a fundraiser for our training staff to purchase supplies that we use throughout the year. However, students can still certainly get a completed physical by their own physician and turn it into the school. Students participating will be walked over to Spain Park gym after school by Berry coaches. Physicals should be completed by 5:00 and students will need a ride no later than 5:15 at the Spain Park Gvm.

Directions:

- 1. Get a blank physical form from outside the main office or print one from our school website (athletics/sports/sports forms//forms/AHSAA Physical).
- 2. Complete the front side of the physical with parents/guardians. Be sure to both sign and date the front of the physical.
- 3. Turn physical (front side completed/backside blank) into Coach Bowden (room 118) *along* with \$20 Payment by Tuesday January 16th.

Payment: Cash or checks will be accepted. For checks, 6th and 7th grade students should make checks payable to Berry Middle School. 8th grade students should make checks payable to Spain Park High School. Checks MUST have phone # and DL # written on the check.

Dress Code Reminders

We have had quite a few dress code violations in the last few weeks. As we start a new semester, please help us remind students of the following Hoover City Schools Dress Code policies:

- #4: Leggings/jeggings/tights are NOT considered pants and <u>must be worn with a</u> long dress or skirt.
- #7: Pants and skirts with holes above the knee are not allowed.
- #8: Shorts, dresses, and skirts must be hemmed and <u>not shorter than mid-thigh</u> <u>when student is seated</u>. Shorts that are torn, in disrepair, or spandex are not allowed.

Protect Your Chromebook

In order to prevent breaks, please consider taking the following precautions to keep chromebooks in good condition:

- Get a chromebook case that stays on the device at all times.
- Only add educational extensions recommended by teachers.
- Don't keep your chromebook in your backpack.
 It can be cracked by the weight of other books or by handling the backpack too roughly.
- Avoid using the chromebook while walking, and don't leave them on the floor.
- Avoid storing the chromebook in lockers unless necessary.
- Treat them as the fragile objects they are be careful!

If your chromebook still needs repair:

- 1. Chromebooks needing repair should be brought to the library.
- 2. When chromebooks return to Berry, they will be stored in the 7th grade office. They will be delivered to students ASAP.

- 3. If a student owes a fee for a repair, they may receive a fee slip rather than a chromebook. However, they may now pay at Berry! Please send any students wanting to make payments with cash or checks to the 7th grade office. They will receive a receipt to bring home to parents, and I will keep another copy of the receipt for our records. Parents may also pay online at https://secure4.myschoolfees.com.
- 4. Payments made online with a Mastercard or Discover or in person in cash will ensure chromebook delivery in a day or two. Payments by check online will have to clear the bank before the chromebook can be returned to the student. This could take up to 10 days a long time when a kid needs a chromebook! Paper checks brought to the 7th grade office must include a phone number, driver's license number, and the student's name.

New Instructions for paying online:

- 1. Go to https://secure4.myschoolfees.com/
- Log in using the e-mail and password you set up during registration.
- 3. Select the "Student Items" tab.
- 4. Select "Show Student Fees" on the **Berry Middle School account** for your child. **Do not use IT account.**
- 5. Select the chromebook fee.
- 6. Click on "add to cart"
- 7. Click on "Checkout."
