Looking to get an early start on your summer academic career? Virginia University of Lynchburg is offering an Online Summer Fast Track Program. This program is designed to prepare college freshmen students for academic success and to give incoming transfer students the opportunity to advance their academic standing.

The cost of Summer Fast Track may be covered in full (\$2,385.00) by federal financial aid (Pell Grant) for those who qualify. *Students must complete the 2020-2021 FAFSA (www.fafsa.ed.gov) application using the school code 003762 in order to determine eligibility and before being accepted.*

FUTURE AGENTS IN TRAINING

Future Agents In Training (FAIT) is an program hosted by the FBI Washington Field Office that invites high school students to receive state of the art criminal investigative training. This program works to educate and inform students about the mission of the FBI including criminal, cyber threats, terrorism and administrative functions. Students learn from special agents, intelligence analysts and a variety of professional staff about investigative tactics that include gathering evidence, interviewing witnesses, and solving cases.

Due to COVID-19 health concerns, this years program will be held **VIRTUALLY** using Microsoft Teams.

ELEGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- ✓ Student is a U.S. Citizen.
- ✓ Student is currently enrolled in, or is graduating from an accredited high school, if student is home schooled, is recognized by a school district.
- ✓ Student must be 16 to 18 years old at the start of the FAIT program.
- ✓ Student has a GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- ✓ Student must electronically submit program application.
- ✓ Student currently resides within Washington D.C. or Northern VA.
