

Senior Parking Spot Paint Information

- Spots will be assigned on August 4. You will need to look for an email from Mrs. Boden in your school email with your assigned space.
- The parking lot will be locked and reserved for painting August 4-11. There are no requests for specific spots. All spaces must be finished by the evening of August 11 to ensure that spaces will be dry before the first day of school. All blockades will be removed on August 12.
- Assigned spots cannot be transferred or switched. Swapping spots for any reason will result in your spot being painted over and you will lose your spot and your payment.
- No refunds will be issued for any reason.
- You will not be able to pull up and park next to your spot. This is an effort to avoid driving over wet parking spots and/or paint supplies that make a bigger mess in the parking lot.
- It will be HOT, so plan accordingly. Here are some suggestions:
 - A tent/canopy for shade, hats, sunscreen.
 - A cooler of cold drinks/water/snacks to stay hydrated.
 - Towels/paper towels for spills/messes/sweat.
 - Lawn chairs.
 - Paint in the morning or in the evening.
- All designs must be school-appropriate and approved in advance by the administration. **Please look for an email from your AP for approval.** If it is not, your spot will be painted over, and you will lose your reserved spot. **PLEASE don't allow your decision to force us to paint over your parking spot.**

- Guidelines:
 - The lot will not be cleaned by a power wash company and you are NOT allowed to power wash your spot. Doing so may damage surrounding areas. Use a scraper, broom, and soapy water.
 - The standard size of a parking spot is 9 feet wide and 18 feet long.
 - You may use any color of paint.
 - Do not use oil-based paint, gloss paints, or sealers. They make the spots too slippery.
 - No spray paint of any kind may be used.
 - It is recommended that you begin with a base coat.
 - If you choose to use a primer, it will create a fast seal before putting down color.
 - Advisors suggest using paint for concrete as a base coat.
 - Do not paint over dividing lines, over your space number, or on the curb.
- Artwork Approval:
 - Artwork must be submitted and approved by administration before you start painting.
 - Use only appropriate words, symbols, and images.
 - No graffiti.
 - **Keep designs neutral; no political statements.**
- All trash, paint materials, and items used during the painting period **MUST** be cleaned and cleared from the parking lot before leaving each day. Bring trashbags with you! **Failure to clean up after yourself could result in the forfeit of your spot.**
- A Senior may only purchase one reserved spot.
- Senior spots are only reserved for use during the school day. We cannot guarantee availability during after school events. If someone is parked in your spot during the school day, please notify a Security Officer or your Assistant Principal.

Any violations can result in a loss of reserved parking. Your fee will be used to clean your spot, and no reimbursements will be made.

We have the right to paint over, confiscate and re-sell spaces that include content that is not approved through the approval process.
