



Fulton County Schools and the state of Georgia are dedicated to meeting the needs of the students and families they serve. As part of this dedication, FCS requests our parents participate in the Georgia Parent Survey. This survey will impact Heards Ferry's CCRPI score, a state-led rating scale of how well schools are preparing students for college and career. Students in grades 3-12 will also be taking the Georgia Student Health Survey. Our students in grades 3-5 will take the survey during the school day. We take this anonymous feedback seriously and would like your input. We are hoping for 100% parent participation.
