Dear RFH Parent(s)/Guardian(s) and Students:

I am writing to inform you of an important change regarding the scheduling of our testing room. As you know, the testing room has been available during study hall, providing a space for students to complete assessments. However, after careful consideration, we have decided to implement a change in response to some recent concerns.

After we return from Spring Break, the testing room will no longer be held during study hall. Instead, we will continue to offer testing during common lunch in the Upper Learning Commons, for those students who have utilized this option during lunch. Additionally, we are introducing an after-school testing session from 2:50 p.m. to 3:50 p.m., also in the Upper Learning Commons, to provide further flexibility for students who require a quiet environment to complete their assessments. As always, students can also make up assessments during teacher office hours as well, which are held two out of the four days before school and the other two days during the common lunch period.

This change is being made due to a recent observation that some students have been selectively absent on test days, opting to take their assessments on later dates. While the vast majority of our students consistently demonstrate excellent academic integrity, we believe it is important to ensure that all students are held to the same standard. By shifting the testing opportunities to these designated times, we hope to discourage some students from being selectively absent and creating a level playing field.
