#### **Important Reminders**

#### Review the FCS Student Code of Conduct

Fulton County Schools' Student Code of Conduct & Discipline Handbook is available online in PDF format <u>HERE</u>. Please take a moment to complete the Acknowledgement of Receipt Form by using the Infinite Campus' Parent Portal (see instructions <u>HERE</u>). **All parents, and students over 10 years old, MUST sign this form**. Paper copies of the Handbook are available in the school's front office.

### Participate Remote Days

Approved Remote Learning Days are a new addition to the Fulton County attendance policy as of last year. Each student can take up to 5 approved remote learning days each semester. These can be used when you have a special family event, required travel, etc. These days must be requested at least 5 days in advance and require principal's approval. These days may not be used on testing days. Here is how the process works:

- Parent notifies homeroom teacher of request to take remote learning days.
- Teacher will provide link to form requesting remote learning days.
- Teachers will provide work for students to complete within 5 days of the absence.

#### Carpool Reminders

Now that we are well into the 1<sup>st</sup> 9 weeks of school, below are a few reminders to ensure everyone is safe during morning carpool

- Please do not let your students out of the car until you see a staff member. We have a lot of students running from the top of the hill.
- Please do not stop on Powers Ferry Road to let your students out on the sidewalk.
- If you are parking next door to drop off your student, you must accompany them through the parking lot to the school.

### Fall Conferences

During the month of October teachers will be holding fall conferences. Parents will have the option to attend conferences in person or virtually. Teachers will be sending a sign up for fall conferences through their weekly S'more newsletters.



#### Classwize



Beginning in October, Fulton County will be implementing a program called Classwize. It is a classroom management tool that allows teachers to see the screens of all devices in a class. Teachers are able to monitor students closely by blocking websites, pushing out websites to them,

sending announcements, and more, as they are using the internet. Teachers can generate a "Student Journey Report" which lists the websites that students have visited as well as screenshots. This is an incredible tool that will ensure students are being great digital citizens at HFE!

#### **Creative Corner**

Looking for engaging ways to nurture your child's creative skills? Check out <u>HFE's Creative Corner website</u>! It is full of opportunities for students to practice their creative thinking skills outside the classroom. There is a creativity menu posted each month for each grade level. #### **Lunch Bunch Volunteers**



Volunteers are needed throughout the school year to help lunchtime run smoothly, especially for our younger children who may need more assistance. There are 2 time slots each day (10:15-11:30 and 11:30-12:30) that are available for volunteers.

#### **Caught SOAR'ing**

Has your child been "caught SOAR'ing" at school? PBIS, an evidence-based framework for helping schools teach students positive behaviors, allows all HFE staff members to give Eagle Points when we "catch" our



students showing SOAR behaviors. SOAR stands for Safe, Outstanding, Accountable, and Respectful. These points can be used to purchase items from their classroom or school store. **IB Units of Study!** Our IB Units of Study are centered around Six Transdisciplinary themes. These units of study are heavily embedded with our Social Studies and Science standards, but the central idea of each unit is applicable to all content areas. Each unit lasts for 6 - 8

weeks, and most students are entering their 2<sup>nd</sup> unit of study! Below is a description of each unit theme.





**HFE INTERNATIONAL INQUIRER PROGRAM...** Remember to ask your child what his/her class is researching about their country of study! Each month, every classroom selects a topic they are interested in, completes their inquiry, and then posts their findings in the hallway!



**COOKIES FOR CHARACTER** October's Learner Profile attribute is a combination of two attributes! **Thinker/Inquirer** is the focus this month and teachers will be looking for that student that demonstrates that he/she is thinking about their learning and asking relevant questions!
