
Westwood Elementary School Newsletter - May 2025

Dear Family,

Good news! INFOhlo (infohlo.org) provides access to BookFlix at no cost to Ohlo families that you and your child can access from home! This interactive digital resource provides a unique read-aloud experience that will help your child develop and practice essential reading skills, and introduce them to a world of knowledge and exploration. BookFlix can be used anytime, anywhere, and on any device with an internet connection—which means that your child can easily extend their learning beyond the school day.

BookFlix includes:

- Classic animated stories, each paired with a related nonfiction ebook
- Spanish language versions
- Read-aloud supports so students can hear each book narrated, and also hear definitions of key words and directions for each activity
- Educational puzzlers so children can show what they have learned
- Safe, age-appropriate weblinks selected by Scholastic editors so kids can extend their learning on a topic
- Meet the Creator section to learn more about each fiction book
