## **Heart of FIRE Scholarship For Graduating Eighth Graders**

Each year, the FIRE Foundation honors students who have demonstrated a *Heart of FIRE* through their support of peers with special needs as friends and classmates.

With a 25-year history of advocacy and support, it's clear to FIRE's stakeholders that inclusive education positively impacts not only the lives of young men and women with special needs, but the lives of their peers as well. Many past students are now studying to become special educators or therapists. Some are pursuing careers in business or other fields and aspire to create more inclusive employment opportunities. Inclusive education is changing our world in a positive way! As you enter high school, then college and your career, YOU can influence others to follow your example.

The FIRE Board of Directors is pleased to award the *Heart of FIRE* Scholarship to one or more graduating eighth grade student(s) at FIRE partner schools. As you continue your education at an area Catholic high school, the Board wishes to recognize your commitment to inclusive education with a scholarship. It is our hope that recipients of the scholarship will someday return to their parishes and communities and continue to share their *Hearts of FIRE* as they keep our mission burning bright.

### ***Scholarship Guidelines and Directions***

1. Award recipients will be determined by a FIRE Board Committee. Prior to review by committee members, essays are redacted (all names are concealed) to ensure objectivity.
2. Graduating eighth grade applicants will submit scholarship entries to the FIRE Foundation by **Wednesday, March 30, 2022**. Email submissions to [info@firefoundation.org](mailto:info@firefoundation.org) with name, current school, phone number and address and the name of the Greater Kansas City area Catholic high school you are planning to attend. Please attach your entry documents in Word or PDF format. **(No Google docs please.)**
3. Scholarship Entries
  - ✓ Submit a typed **essay** (not to exceed 500 words) describing the impact that inclusive education has made on your life and how you think your experiences and the people you have met are likely to influence your future (your values, your faith, your career choice, etc.)
  - ✓ Share a story (or two!) about your friendship and/or experiences helping a student with special learning needs. Try to include interesting or unique details.
  - ✓ Include a response to this question: *Why should all Catholic schools welcome, include and support students with intellectual and developmental disabilities?*
  - ✓ The review committee will consider your experiences as an inclusion advocate first and foremost. The committee will also evaluate your sincerity, creativity and polish of your essay.
  - ✓ A recommendation completed by a teacher, administrator, coach or other adult who knows you well (no immediate family) must be submitted for entry to be considered. *(See page 2 for additional details.)* Your submission will not be considered without a recommendation.
4. Scholarship winners will be notified on a date selected by your school administration. Principals will be notified of award recipient(s) by April 22, 2022.
5. Winning entry(ies) will receive an award of up to \$1,000 for tuition/fees at the student's chosen Catholic high school.
6. FIRE reserves the right to post and publish entries on the Foundation's publications, website and social media.



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RECOMMENDATION for Heart of FIRE Scholarship for Graduating Eighth Graders

RECOMMENDATIONS ARE REQUIRED. Please follow through and complete your recommendation on or before the deadline so your student's entry will be considered for a high school scholarship award.
RECOMMENDATIONS ARE INFLUENTIAL. Please share details or stories that illustrate the applicant's commitment to inclusion as a student and a friend.
MULTIPLE RECOMMENDATIONS. It is acceptable for one individual to submit recommendations for more than one student.
