Cell Phones

We are seeing an increase in students using their cell phones during the school day. Per our school policy, cell phones should be off and out of sight while the student is on campus. Students caught using their cell phones during the school day will have their phones confiscated and will need to be picked up by a parent/guardian. Cell phones are a



distraction on campus, and they are one of the leading ways that students are inappropriately interacting with each other. If you do not have a filter on your child's cell phone, we would highly encourage you to provide this safeguard for your child. We also ask parents/guardians not to call their child during the school day; please contact the front office if you need to speak with them.

Progressing Monitoring

The state legislature changed how Florida is assessing our students. FSA is gone, and we now have Progress Monitoring.

The idea was to provide students, teachers, and parents with information about student progress throughout the year so that we can adjust instruction and fill in gaps before the year-end assessment in May. The first round of progress monitoring is complete. Progress Monitoring results have gone home in your student's folder. Please take a moment to look at the results. The students were assessed on the material they will learn throughout the school year, so, understandably, scores may be low. This provides a good baseline, and we will refer to these scores throughout the first semester.

Uniform Concerns

Apparently, the new fashion trend for some students is to roll their shorts up and expose their underwear. We can all agree that bringing back some of the '80s fashion with rolling shorts is not a good idea. We also can't allow students to expose their underwear. We have asked students to unroll their shorts and ensure their underwear is not exposed. Please reiterate this to your student.
