Alamance-Burlington Schools PLAN B proposal at-a-glance

Plan B is a blended learning model that includes designated days for in-person instruction and days designated for remote instruction. Schools are limited to NO greater than 50% maximum occupancy.

Decide what is best for your family. Would you like to continue with a remote instruction only option, or send students to school following the Plan B guidance?

If you choose the remote only option, your family will still be able to receive lunches from the schools.

At this time High Schools will remain under Plan C, remote instruction only, until the end of the first semester in January 2021.

The schedule for blended learning will change. Please see the student breakdown and new school start and end times.

Students with last names **A-K** will attend school on **Monday and Tuesday.** Students with last names **L-Z** will attend school on **Thursday and Friday**. All students will receive remote instruction on Wednesdays. *Special consideration will be given for families with students that may have different last names.*

Elementary Schools will operate from **7:50am - 2:35pm** Middle Schools will operate from **9:15am-4:30pm** *Under Plan B, transportation protocols will require us to adjust school times.*



SCHOOL

Pre-K students will attend Monday-Friday from 7:50am-2:35pm (*this is a federal program*). Adaptive Curriculum classrooms will attend Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday. Adaptive Curriculum students will participate in remote instruction on Wednesdays.

Schools that have historically offered before-school and after-school care programs will continue to offer those with additional safety guidelines in place.

Transportation protocols under Plan B require bus riders to present an attestation before boarding the bus. Students will also be socially distanced on the bus, one student per seat. Everyone must wear a mask while riding any school transportation. Bus riders will be screened when they reach school.





Plan B requires enhanced safety protocols. Health screenings (temperature checks) are required before anyone enters the buildings. Face masks will be required for everyone on school property. Floor and hallway signage will be present across the building. Special cleaning requirements have already begun, and will continue, for buildings, transportation, and high-touch surfaces.
