#### Credit for Work

Are You Working? Did you know you could earn Course Credit?

**Credit for Work Experience Applications** are now being accepted for present work experience. Program Overview: The program is designed to allow students to earn graduation credit for real-world experience by working at a part-time job. This is a pass/fail course offering students in grades 11 & 12 working at an after school job, an opportunity to earn additional .5 credit for every 70 hours worked. That is not to exceed a total of 2 credits or 280 hours during their high school experience. Enrollment in this course requires the submission of a completed Credit for Work Experience application:

• Academic school year applications for afterschool jobs must be submitted by Sept. 30, 2020.

• Students will not receive credit for hours worked prior to application approval.

#### **10<sup>TH</sup> GRADE**

*Virginia Space Coast Scholars (VSCS)* – Online course for 10<sup>th</sup> grade students focusing on missions flown or managed by NASA Wallops Flight Facility on Virginia's Eastern Shore, with a week-long summer academy program at NASA Wallops Flight Facility. **http://vsgc.odu.edu/spacecoast/** 

#### 11<sup>TH</sup> AND 12<sup>TH</sup> GRADE

*Virginia Aerospace Science and Technology Scholars (VASTS)* – Online course for 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grade students focusing on NASA's human spaceflight missions and the Journey to the Moon and on to Mars with a week-long summer academy at NASA Langley Research Center. Students can earn up to four free dual enrollment college credits. http://vsgc.odu.edu/VASTS/

#### 11<sup>TH</sup> AND 12<sup>TH</sup> GRADE

*Virginia Earth System Science Scholars (VESSS)* – This interactive online earth system science course for 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grade students features NASA scientific research and data. Students can earn up to five dual enrollment college credits and can also be selected to attend a summer academy program at NASA Langley Research Center. http://vsgc.odu.edu/VESSS

Our online course applications are **OPEN UNTIL OCTOBER 25<sup>th</sup>** for  $10^{th} - 12^{th}$  grade students to apply.
