First Days of School (August 17 & 18):

Beginning August 21, 2021: KCAL's 1st period begins at 7:40 am with the doors opening at 7:30. Please do not drop off or arrive before 7:30 as no staff will be available. KCAL's bell schedule is different from the home campus bell schedule to accommodate the need to transport students to KCAL and back to their home campus. All KCAL shuttles will be labeled with magnets indicating the campus that the bus will be shuttling back and forth from.



All student parking locations are in green. Staff/visitor parking are in yellow. A blue line is painted in the south parking lot indicating where staff parking stops, and student parking begins (as seen in the picture below).

Due to the limited access to our campus, we encourage students to ride the shuttles from their home campuses. Parent drop-off and pick-up will take place in the south parking lot in the lane closest to Bursey Road (labeled in the lane below as staff parking / student parking). Patience is going to be required the first few weeks as we train student drivers, bus drivers, and parents with the limited amount of space available while we are under construction.

Students interested in parking at KCAL must complete the KCAL Parking Lottery form. They will need to use their Keller ISD email and credentials to complete the form. As parking is limited, priority will be given to seniors. Students will need to check their KISD email for a follow-up parking email with all information to complete the process and get their parking permit. No students can drive to KCAL without the parking permit in hand prior to arriving on campus. KCAL Parking Permits will cost \$10 and this will allow students to park in the designated student parking on campus OR at Northwood Church.
