**ATTENDANCE** - Student attendance is to be regular and punctual. Students are responsible to make up missed work when they are absent. All absences must be verified by a written note, email or call to the office from a parent/guardian upon returning to school stating the date and reason for absence. If your child has been ill with a communicable disease, had surgery, or is wearing a cast/splint, they must report to the Health Office upon return with a note from the doctor.

**LATE/TARDY** - Any student who enters school after 8:05 am is late (29 minutes or less) or tardy (30 minutes plus). A total of 3 tardy markings equals an Unexcused Absence. Please try to schedule doctor's appointments outside of the instructional day. If you attend an appointment during school hours, you must bring a doctor's note to receive an excused tardy. These same rules apply to being picked up early.

**CLASSROOM INTERRUPTIONS** - Students are to be prepared for school each day with all the materials that they need including backpacks, homework/projects, jackets, snacks/lunches etc. Instructional time will not be disrupted to call students for forgotten items nor will items be delivered to class. Any items that are brought to the office will be placed on the counter for students to pick up - Students must come to the office on their own during recess/lunch to check if missing items have been dropped off.

**PARTIES/INVITATIONS:** Party invitations should not be given out at school. Please do not bring any food items to celebrate birthdays. You may arrange with the teacher to donate non-food items (i.e. pencils, books, etc.).

**CAFETERIA** - Free breakfast and lunch is available for ALL students as well as after school snacks for students attending the after school program. Students may also bring food from home.
