Dear Running Creek Families,

As we head into fall break, I would like to sincerely thank all of you. I am grateful for the opportunity to be a part of this school and to work with your children every day. I take great pride in being here and working alongside such a wonderful staff and student body. Please know that I do everything in my power to ensure your children's safety while they are here.

Since we will have a week off, please be mindful of the following upon our return:

Carpool Lane (Parking Lot Area)

This is a Kiss and Go system. For the safety of both students and parents and to keep the area clear of accidents, please have students exit vehicles on the passenger side only. Please also ensure that your car line pick-up form is clearly visible.

Parent Pick-Up (Front of Building)

Please ensure that you are not blocking the front entrance/exit while buses are loading. This procedure allows us to get our bus riders on board efficiently so the buses can proceed to their next school pickups. Additionally, please be considerate and do not stand in the bus loop so the buses have sufficient space to exit.

Visitor Management System

When entering the building, you will be asked to sign in on the visitor management system. Therefore, please ensure you have a government-issued ID with you, such as a driver's license. District policy requires that anyone entering the building must be signed in and out, wear the provided name tag, and may be accompanied by a district employee for some or all of their visit.

Please note: If a visitor refuses to follow these rules, their visitation may be limited, denied, or revoked by a school administrator, and law enforcement may be called to further enforce policy provisions.

Dear Running Creek Families,

Running Creek Elementary will be conducting **vision and hearing screenings on Tuesday, October 21, 2025**. These screenings are conducted to meet the requirements set forth by C.R.S. 22-1-116 and to help identify any concerns that may affect your child's learning and development.

Screenings will include students in **kindergarten**, **first**, **second**, **third**, **and fifth grades**, as well as **any fourth-grade student who is new to the Elizabeth School District**. If you have specific concerns regarding your child's hearing or vision, please reach out to Ashley Keith at akeith@esdk12.org.

If your child wears glasses or contacts or uses any form of hearing support, please ensure they bring them to school on the day of the screening.

If you **do not want your child to participate**, please email Ashley Keith at akeith@esdk12.org to opt out.

Parents/guardians will be notified within one week if a concern is identified with their child's vision or hearing. Thank you for your support in helping us care for the health and success of all of our RCE students.
