Afternoon Walker/Bike Rider Change

As our community continues to grow, RSES wants to remain flexible and constantly seek to better meet the needs of our students and families. We have noticed many students who are part of the WHITE walker and GOLD walker lines are crossing additional streets to the north and west of campus through traffic. In order to promote safety for these students, we are creating an additional walking route from the campus which will take students back west along Bonnet Blvd. Please see the map above for the location where students will be released. Students in the GREEN line will **not** cross Bonnet Blvd. If a student needs to cross to the other side of Bonnet Blvd., he or she needs to remain in the GOLD line. A parent permission form will be coming home next week for you to inform us if your student currently leaves the school in another line, and you would like to switch him/her to the new GREEN walker line. As always, all students will be escorted by a RSES staff member to their walker locations. Students that are in Pre-K, Kindergarten, and First Grade, **MUST** be met by an adult.

Makerspace in the Library Kicks Off Tomorrow!

What is Makerspace?

With technology being readily available to a large percentage of the student population, either at home or throughout the school day, the library is presented with a unique opportunity to take those devices and enhance the lessons and activities. Ediaz (2017) states providing the use of what is considered makerspace materials "is only the latest manifestation of the library's natural role in encouraging and facilitating the creativity and ingenuity of its community of users." It is our responsibility to ensure we are doing everything in our power to keep kids engaged, current with the times, and the feeling of a library someplace they want to continue to visit throughout their lifetime. Libraries are moving away

from being a quick place to run in and grab a book toward becoming a future-ready space where students are introduced to problem-solving and critical thinking skills outside of a traditional classroom setting. "It's about creating a space that encourages students to dream and wonder and design" (Spencer, 2018).
