### **TELPAS Testing**

The Writing portion of the Texas English Language Proficiency Assessment System (TELPAS) administration begins this week. TELPAS is a state-mandated test for all English Learners - those students who receive ESL services. All ESL students who are face-to-face will complete the Writing portion of TELPAS in their Math, Science, English, and Social Studies classes February 8 - 19, 2021 at NSSH. All ESL students who are virtual will complete the Writing portion of TELPAS in the Google Meets of their Math, Science, English, and Social Studies classes February 8 -19, 2021. All virtual ESL students must be present during the Google Meets and must turn on their camera for the entirety of the Writing portion of TELPAS. Again, this is a state-mandated test; all ESL students must participate.
