

# **District Communication Regarding COVID-19 Notifications**

LHISD has a variety of approved communication channels to send and receive information to and from parents. Remind is one of the channels teachers currently use for classroom or extra-curricular communication. Beginning September 21st the Heath Services department will be sending COVID-19 notifications to parents using Remind vs. Skyward or email. The district is moving to this platform as it's functionality will provide a faster and easier notification process for our Health Service team and parents during this challenging time. All campuses will be participating in this initiative.



## **Online Student Absence Form**

You may now report a student absence online. If you visit our <u>Rancho Sienna District Page</u> at the bottom of the screen there is a 'Student Absence Form'. This allows you access to report your student absence at any time. The form also allows you to attach a personal or doctor's note.



# Reporting an Absence, Doctor's & Parents Notes

To track the well-being of our students and to follow COVID-19 District guidelines, this year it is very important that health communication is being shared with our teachers and campus Nurse. If your child will be missing school due to other illness's or symptoms of COVID-19, please let your child's teacher and Nurse Carpenter know as soon as possible along with submitting a note upon your child's return to school.



## **COVID After Hours Reporting**

LHISD and Rancho Sienna Elementary are committed to the safety, health and well-being of all students and district members. In and effort to support students and families after hours, LHISD has added the following resource to our district 'Return to Learn' resources.

**The After Hours Positive COVID-19 Reporting Form** has been added to the main <u>Return to Learn</u> website at the top right hand side, under the Family Updates button.

 Please complete <u>this form</u> should you receive information after 4:00 PM that your LHISD enrolled child tests Positive for COVID-19. All members of the same household should quarantine until further instruction from the LHISD Exposure Team or the local health department.

Does Your Child Walk Home from School??

Your child's safety is our first priority. Please ensure that you child is exiting the school property from the correct colored crosswalk. These color zones are designated to minimize crossing of major streets and direct students towards a crossing guard if needing to cross a street. Crossing guards are located at the STOP signs. You will see that parts of our neighborhood may select from different colors. However, we ask that student living on the north side of the Bonnet Blvd to be Gold Walkers and cross Bonnet Blvd with a crossing guard. If after reviewing this map you would like to make a color change, please complete a permanent transportation change request <a href="here">here</a> and a new backpack tag to coordinate to their colored zone will be issued to your child.

We would ask that parents use the car line if driving to campus to pick up your student(s). Cars parked along the streets and near crossing guards during dismissal times limit the line of sight for cars in the car line and also put our students at risk who are walking. Our car line is fast and clear on most days by 3:15, so please utilize this pick up to help us keep our students safe.




## **Learning Choices 2nd Six Weeks - Selection Opens Soon**



# **LHISD Fightin' Panther Club**

#### What is the FPC?
