CMAS State Testing Update for Spring 2021

In Person Students

In person students will be assessed in the required CMAS assessments starting April 20.

Required in-person assessments

Sixth grade students will take the CMAS Math on April 20 & 21.

Seventh grade students will take the CMAS English Language Arts on April 20 & 21.

Eighth grade students will take the CMAS Math and CMAS Science on April 20, 21 & 22.

Opting into non-required, in-person assessments

Families have the option of opting into the grade level portions of the CMAS that are not required.

Opt-in assessments will begin on April 23 and be completed by April 30.

Test Day Schedules

CMAS will occur during the students' Core class blocks (English, Math, Science, and Social Studies classes). Students will attend exploratory classes as normal on testing days. Sixth and Seventh grade exploratory will be at their normal time, eighth grade exploratory will run from 10:45 – 12:20.

With the exception of students' exploratory class noted above, there will be no academic instruction, in-person, asynchronous, or remote, during the designated testing schedule assigned at each grade level.
