Christmas House provides an opportunity for qualifying, low-income, Snohomish County parents to select free holiday gifts for their children age infant - 18 yrs old.

**Numbers will be passed out daily Nov. 29- Dec. 16 starting at 6:30 a.m. until one hour before closing time or until the numbers are gone, whichever occurs first.** To qualify to shop at Christmas House, you must:

- be a resident of Snohomish County,
- have children aged 18 or younger living in your custody, have a household income at or below 150% of the poverty level, as defined by the United States Department of Health and Human Services ([View 2018 Income Chart](#)).
- ID, proof of spouse/significant other living in household, proof of income, proof of child custody and Snohomish County residency are required.

★Toys for Tots – Smokey Point to Shoreline

To qualify you must be a US citizen and reside within the service area (Smokey Point to Shoreline). You must have valid Washington State ID or military ID card and proof of residence to pick up toys.

Applications are open for Single Parent/Guardians/Families. **IF YOU ARE A TANF RECIPIENT PLEASE CONTACT YOUR LOCAL DSHS OFFICE OR YOUR CASE WORKER FOR PROCEDURES AFTER OCTOBER 15, 2018.**
