



Attendance Matters

Build the Habit of Good Attendance Now!

Why It Matters



Starting in Kindergarten, too many absences can cause children to fall behind in school. Students can still fall behind if they miss just a day or two every few weeks.



What To Do

Attending school regularly helps children feel better about themselves and school. Build this habit in preschool, because every day is important. Good attendance helps children do well in high school, college, and work.



Missing 10% (or about 18 days) can make it harder to learn to read.



Set a regular bed time and morning routine.

Lay out clothes and pack backpacks the night before.



Being late to school may lead to poor attendance.



Don't let your child stay home unless they're truly sick. A stomach ache or headache can be a sign of anxiety, not a reason to stay home.



Develop back-up plans for getting to school. Call on a family members, neighbor, or another parent.



Absences can affect the whole classroom if the teacher has to slow down learning to help children catch up.



Avoid medical appointments and extended trips when school is in session.




MINUTES LATE	IMPACT ON YOUR ATTENDANCE IN A YEAR

20 MINUTES A DAY =	13.8 days 92.9% attendance
30 MINUTES A DAY =	20.7 days 89.2% attendance


The Importance of Forgiveness
