**Downingtown East Weekly Updates from the Principal...**

The **DEI Director Justin Brown** will facilitate a one period meeting with our **9th grade students on November 3<sup>rd</sup>**. He will be conducting icebreakers and team builders that will help students interact with each other in fun and creative ways. During his presentation, he will be discussing what DEI means for our district including showing kindness, using empathy and the importance of inclusivity within our schools.

**Help Your Student Find Their Voice...**

This school year, there's been a prolonged adjustment period to starting back to school for many of our kids. The academic disruption caused by the pandemic was obvious, but experts are also finding that our youth seems significantly behind socially as well. These two deficits collide when students find themselves with questions or concerns about their academics, as the best course of action has always been for them to first talk with their teacher. Unfortunately, many kids find asking their teachers for help to be difficult, affecting their academic performance, self-esteem, and access to learning in the future. Here are a few suggestions that may help:

1. Students must first recognize where they are struggling while being able to see themselves as capable of success. This requires honesty and self-awareness while feeling supported by those they love and trust. As a parent, you know your child best and can offer them the clearest insight as to where they should focus, while drawing attention to their strengths and prior accomplishments.
2. Help students understand that teachers want to help. Asking students of any age why an adult would choose teaching as a career can be an eye-opening—and often humorous!
3. Brainstorm conversation starters. Students who are introverted or out of practice in initiating conversation may feel overwhelmed or anxious about doing so with their teacher. Practicing or role-playing this kind of conversation can help students build confidence.
4. Help them determine how they'll feel most secure when asking. Students need to feel safe in order to be vulnerable enough to ask for help. Suggest they speak to their teacher when others aren't around, like before or after school, or class. Additionally, you could encourage your child to email or Schoology message their teacher first, paving the way for a more comfortable and productive conversation in school.
5. Remind your child that we as humans can't expect to know everything. The most successful people are those who can reach out to and ask for help. Reaching out to others to ask for help is not a weakness — it is a sign of strength, confidence, and the desire to do well.

**2021-22 AP EXAM PAYMENTS:**

PaySchools Central will **open Monday, October 4** and **closes Friday, October 29** for AP Exam payments. Your child's account will show an AP Exam fee for each AP course they are taking. You should pay for the exam(s) that your child wants to take in the spring.

***Any exams ordered AFTER College Board's deadline OR exams that are CANCELED/UNUSED will incur a \$40 penalty by College Board.***

**\*\*Students are required to take the AP exam to earn AP weighted grading of 1.0 credits. Students enrolled in AP classes, but NOT taking the exam, will earn Honors weighted grading of .5 credits. \*\***

**Exam Registration:**

AP students **must** register themselves through their College Board accounts for the online AP Classroom associated with **each** of their AP classes. Teachers have given students a unique "join code" for each class to do that. AP Classroom is an

online platform by College Board that offers many resources to support students in exam preparation. This is also how students register for their exams. **If students do not join their online AP Classroom, an exam cannot be ordered for them.**

Students can go to [myap.collegeboard.org](http://myap.collegeboard.org) to join their online AP Classroom. If students are having an issue with their College Board account, they must contact College Board: 888-225-5427.
