## NEWS and INFORMATION

### 1. IMPORTANT REMINDERS FOR ALL FAMILIES

#### **Late to School**

We had a great start to the year with respect to students being tardy to school. Unfortunately, we are seeing a pretty massive increase of kids late in the morning. **Please speak with your student about being on time (which means being inside the classroom when the clock strikes 7:30).** For most of the kids, if they just got out the door 1 or 2 minutes earlier, they would be on time every day. Thanks in advance for helping us get back to where we were in the fall when nearly all kids were on-time to school.

#### **Absent from School**

Please remember that if your student is absent from school, that absence needs to be excused within 2 school days. Unexcused absences can result in discipline, loss of credit or even a court appearance - so please get all those absences excused. Please check ParentVue regularly and if you forgot to excuse an absence, please call or email the Attendance Office (info on how is [HERE](#)).

## 2. Halloween Costume Rules for North Creek

Students wishing to wear costumes to school, football games, or other school-related events must keep these guidelines in mind:

- Regular school dress code applies (underclothing/lingerie is not appropriate as a costume - please refer to district and school dress code policy).
- Costumes should not, in any way, disrupt the learning environment (ability to carry school supplies, being seated in class, blocking view of others, etc.).
- Costumes may not demean any race, ethnic group, disabling condition, religion, nationality, gender, gender identity or sexual orientation.
- Costumes cannot reflect graphic violence or gang affiliation.
- No face or pullover masks. Faces must be completely visible.
- No props or look-a-like weapons of any kind (i.e. anything you can hold in your hands is a prop, for example, swords, baseball bats, etc.).
- No silly string or toy-like accessories.
- Shoes must be worn.
- Pacifiers, baby bottles, false teeth, anything placed in mouth, and glow sticks are not allowed. These items are considered paraphernalia associated with drug use.
- NO CLOWN COSTUMES – We are asking for your cooperation in not allowing students to dress up as clowns at any school event due to the disruption and fear it may cause. If anyone shows up with a clown-related costume, they will be asked to change or be sent home.

Keep in mind that all school guidelines still apply. Students will be expected to comply with requests of staff members to make the appropriate changes in dress/costume. The success of this day, as always, will impact consideration of future dress up days.

If you have any questions as to whether the costume is appropriate or not, please ask an administrator before the costume is worn to school or a school event.

Thank you for your cooperation and assistance in helping to make wear costumes fun but not disruptive or inappropriate.

## 3. A Request from Pop Keeney Staff

I have been made aware by our support staff at Pop Keeney that some North Creek parents are being extremely rude to the ticket-takers at the Pop. Here is what I received from the Facilities Supervisor at Pop Keeney:

*I'm also reaching out asking for your help and support. Within the last month we have high increase in hostile parents coming to the stadium. Many continue to yell, curse, and other words at my sellers and ticket takers for having to pay to come to soccer games. I'm not sure why this is happening lately since we do not make the rules for selling tickets nor do we set the price. My goal is to continue to have a safe environment at PK and a great culture where people can come to enjoy watching their kids. Yelling or any abusive language to our staff down there can not be acceptable.*

Please remember that the decision about which sports charge for admission and the price of that admission are made by WIAA and KingCo - not Northshore or the folks at Pop Keeney.

In the future, let's show the Pop Keeney staff how much we appreciate their hard efforts in creating a safe, fun environment for our kids and families! A simple "thank you!" and a smile go a long way.
