Student Medication Pick Up

I hope everyone is staying safe and healthy during this time. As we begin to wrap up our end of year duties, the first task will be to get your child's medication back to you. On **Tuesday April 28th, from 8am-4pm**, Nurse Carpenter will be at the school to sign out your child's medication to you. Please follow the procedures listed below to ensure this is done safely and efficiently.

- 1. Please park in the front parking lot and follow the directions on the posted signs. **Please wear a** mask or face covering if you have one. We will also be wearing one.
- 2. The front office/school building will not be open to the public for any reason. No other items will be picked up during this time. The front foyer area between the double doors is where you may wait one at a time, while waiting for Nurse Carpenter to collect your child's medication.
- 3. Please maintain social distancing if you are waiting in line outside (just like waiting to get into the grocery store.)
- 4. Please have your ID available to show as this will be verified in your student's Skyward account. If someone else will be picking up your child's medication, an email must be sent to Nurse Carpenter prior to Tuesday 4/28/2020 regarding this and they must have their ID as well. jcarpenter@libertyhill.txed.net

This is the only way medication may be picked up. We cannot keep medication over the summer. Any medication not picked up will be disposed of on a later date. If you have any questions, please contact Nurse Carpenter by email at jcarpenter@libertyhill.txed.net
