The "ABCs of Schooling:

#### **Behavior**

The last edition of the Chatter included our five core school rules within the bus safety piece. Reading the rules leads one to wonder, "What happens when rules are broken?" While we aim to emphasize proactive, positive approaches to school and classroom discipline that first establish structures in which students can be successful, then teach them how to follow those structures, inevitably, consequences will sometimes be needed.

Students whose choices violate school rules will experience progressive consequences such as warnings, rule review/practice, or lost privileges. Students may be assigned to review policy, engage in reteaching lessons, mediate with peers, or write letters of apology. We use alternate cafeteria seating, walking the playground perimeter (keeps kids moving and thinking), recess or lunch detention and in or out-ofschool suspension when needed. Always, our goal is that students will make a more helpful choice next time.

Thanks so much for ordering and we'll have those out to students as soon as they arrive!




