This week we start our state testing. Every year, students in grades 3-8 take SC READY. This assessment was designed to assess students in their reading, writing, math, and science standards. Our teachers taught the standards and have

differentiated the lessons to assist students who were struggling as well as those who already mastered the standards.

Here is where you, as parent, can set your child up for success. Be sure to have your child to school on time. Breakfast is available to any student who would like to eat at school - this is a great option if you are running a little late in the morning. All cell phones and smart watches must be turned off and in the backpack. It would be wonderful if you had your child leave their cell phones and smart watches at home. - If your child needs medication provided to them during the school day, please contact the nurse and complete the required form.



PTO SPIRIT ROCK

WHAT IS THE SPIRIT ROCK?

• The spirit rock is an exciting way to celebrate birthdays, accomplishments, celebrations, well wishes, congratulatory messages, upcoming school events or inspiring messages.

• The rock is a fun way to spread any kind of positive message. Please note any use of profanity, symbols, offensive and political messages are not permitted.

• Painting the rock is one of many traditions that people can participate in with their friends and family.

RESERVATIONS MUST BE MADE TO PAINT THE ROCK. RENTER IS RESPONSIBLE FOR PROVIDING SUPPLIES AND PAINTING THE ROCK. RAIN OR SHINE.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

• RESERVATIONS ARE FIRST COME, FIRST SERVE BASIS.

• The cost is \$15.00 per day and can be rented for no more than 2 consecutive days at a time.

• You may begin painting the spirit rock at 4:00 PM on the day BEFORE your reserved date and your session will expire at 3:59 PM the day of your reservation, to ensure anyone scheduled the next day has time to paint.

• **STEP 1** - Check the availability of the date you would like to reserve on the Myrtle Beach Elementary School's website under PTO tab, **PTO SPIRIT ROCK CALENDAR**: <u>https://www.horrycountyschools.net/Myrtle_Beach_Elementary</u>

• **STEP 2** - If your date is available, send an email to <u>MBEPTOSeahawks@gmail.com</u> requesting to reserve the date - Please include your name, child's name, type of message you are painting and if it's a 1 or 2 day rental.

• STEP 3 - The Spirit Rock Coordinator will respond to confirm that the date is available for rental.

• **STEP 4** - You must pay within 24 hours after receiving the confirmation email to secure the reservation. Payments can only be made through our online Square account on the PTO Spirit Rock page under *Spirit Rock Payment information* or with the links below. **With your card payment, you will be charged a service fee**

• **STEP 5** - Your reservation will be published to the calendar and reserved once payment has been processed and you will receive a 2nd email confirming your reservation. - If your payment is not received in the time frame, PTO reserves the right to offer the date to someone else.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

• The spirit rock may NOT be painted during school hours.

• MBE PTO is not responsible for missed or forgotten reservations, no refunds will be given once your date is paid and confirmed. No glitter, glue or 3-D objects may be used due to the difficulty of removing them for the next reservation.

• The family or group painting the rock assumes liability for any individual or member of the group who incurs clothing or other personal property damage or school property damages.

• School administrators and PTO reserve the right to and will exercise such right to make judgements on the status of the rock.

• Any painting that is deemed to be inappropriate will be removed/repainted.

•100% of your donation goes back to Myrtle Beach Elementary School PTO, THANK YOU!

• The RENTER is responsible for painting the rock at MBE. If for some reason the rock at another school is painted, it is the RENTERS responsibility to correct the mistake.

• You will typically need 2-3 cans of spray paint for the base coat and additional paint for your design. You can use latex paint as well. For more intricate designs, craft paint, foam brushes and even stencils work great.

• You are responsible for providing all materials and ensuring the area around the spirit rock remains clean, free of trash and debris. Please make sure to ONLY paint the rock and protect the grass, sidewalk and road.
