


Parent & Student Handbook

SPOTLIGHT ON SAFETY

Ten Oaks Elementary School is committed to the safety of all who enter the building.. Please be advised of the following security measures in place.

SECURITY SCREENINGS



For safety and security purposes, a remotely activated entry system has been installed. To be granted entry into the building, please press the "call" button on the intercom panel beside the far right front entry door. The secretaries will answer and give you instructions for entering. All individuals must go through metal detectors when entering the building.

CLEAR BAG POLICY

Horry County Schools has implemented a Clear Bag Policy upon entering schools and athletic events. This policy enhances safety and speeds up entry.



Approved Bags Include:

- Clear plastic/vinyl bags (no larger than 12" x 6" x 12")
- One-gallon clear plastic freezer bags
- Small clutch bags (no larger than 4.5" x 6.5")
- Medically necessary items (subject to inspection)
- Diaper bags (with an infant/toddler, subject to inspection)

Prohibited Bags Include:

- Backpacks
- Purses larger than a clutch
- Briefcases
- Fanny packs
- Drawstring bags
- Luggage
- Camera/computer bags
