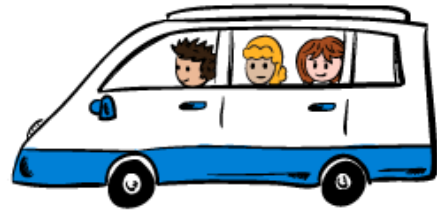

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Horry County Schools Athletics Clear Bag Policy

In order to provide a safe and secure environment for our parents, community members, students, athletes, staff, and officials, Horry County Schools will implement a Clear Bag Policy for all football and basketball games effective August 2018. School staff will continue to implement security checkpoints and approved bag searches.

Approved Bags

- Clear plastic or vinyl bags that do not exceed 12" x 6" x 12"
- One-gallon clear plastic freezer bag
- Small clutch bags no larger than 4.5" x 6.5" – approximately the size of a hand, with or without a handle or strap
- Medically necessary items (after proper inspection at the entrance)
- Diaper bags (with an infant/toddler – after proper inspection at the entrance)

Prohibited bags include, but are not limited to:

- Purses larger than a clutch bag
- Briefcases
- Backpacks
- Fanny packs
- Cinch/Drawstring bags
- Luggage of any kind
- Computer bags/Camera Bags

Other Prohibited items include, but are not limited to:

- Coolers
- Weapons/concealed weapons
- Alcoholic beverages
- Containers of any kind
- Aerosol and spray cans
- Mace/pepper spray
- Animals (except service animals)
- Laser lights, strobe lights, and pointers
- Irritants such as artificial noisemakers
- Fireworks/explosives
- Inflatables (beach balls, etc.)
- Masks of any kind
- Drones

*Medically Necessary & Diaper Bags must be properly inspected by Security Personnel at the entrance!

Frequently Asked Questions

Why is Horry County Schools adopting this policy for football and basketball events?

The safety and security of our fans, community members, and students is our number one priority? This proactive measure will enhance the safety inside our stadiums and gymnasiums and will speed up the screening process.

What happens if I arrive to the game with a bag that is not permitted?

Fans with a prohibited bag will not be permitted inside the stadium or gymnasium. Fans will need to return the prohibited bag to their vehicle.

How does this expedite my entry into the stadium or gymnasium?

This policy enables us to move guests through our security checkpoints faster, allowing staff to be more efficient and effective in checking approved bags that are brought into the venue.

What about items such as stadium seats and blankets?

Fans will be allowed to enter with a stadium seat and/or blanket. These items are easily screened.

Why is this policy not being instituted for other sporting events?

Basketball and football games are the two sports offered in Horry County Schools that have the largest crowds in attendance. We will continue to monitor attendance at other sporting events to determine future changes.

Cheerleaders will be selling clear game day totes that adhere to the new Horry County clear bag policy. Orders can be made at open house and bags will be delivered before the first B-Team Game. Dimensions are 12" x 12" x 6".

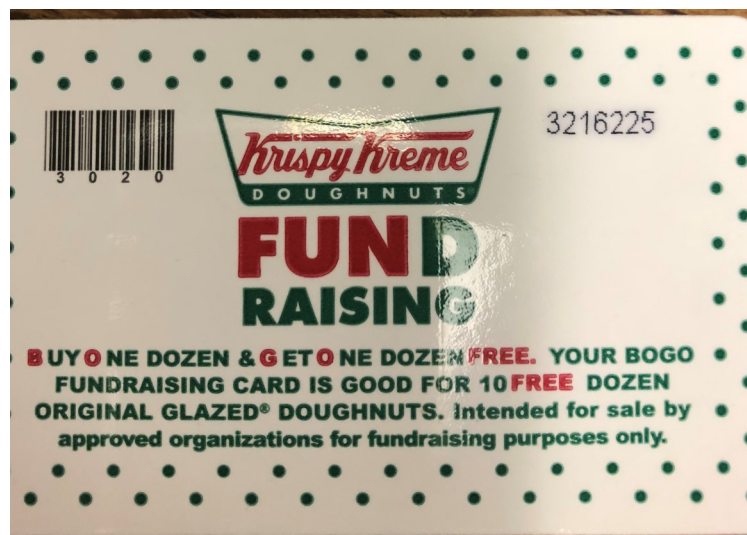

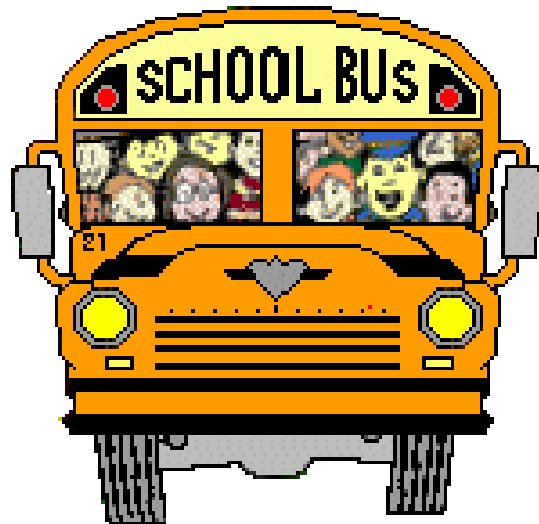

Dear Parent/Guardian:

In 2017 Horry County Schools implemented a new electronic registration system for athletics. Parents and students are required to create an online account and complete the pre-participation physical packet online. The online packet must be completed before any participation in athletic activities will be allowed. To complete this process, please follow the instructions outlined below.

If you have already completed a parent and student account previously on PlanetHS, then simply log in using your same account username and password and complete the required information for 2018-2019.

Visit www.arbiterathlete.com and click "sign up" or "log in". You may also text a school code (see below) to 69274 to sign up. **Do not create an account or sign any forms before April 1, 2018.**

BOTH parents and student need to make separate accounts and then LINK the two accounts. See below for instructions on how to link parent and student accounts and complete the physical forms online.

Athlete/Parent Account Registration and Pre-Participation Form Completion

1. Go to www.arbiterathlete.com and click "sign up".
2. Parent **AND** Student will need to make separate accounts
 - A. Students, please enter your legal first, middle and last name
 - B. Students, it is recommended that you use your HCS email and password.

 - C. Please chose the school at which the student will be participating.
 - D. Students and Parents, if you come to a field that does not apply to you, please type N/A
3. Once logged in to either parent or student account:
 - A. Click Athletic Forms
 - B. Click Athletic Participation
 - C. Scroll down and click "**Link Accounts**" and enter the email address or phone number of the parent/student who needs to be linked.
4. The other person will receive an email/text to confirm linking accounts. They will see the invite and click "Approve".
5. Once the accounts are linked, you will follow steps A-B again and then scroll all the way to the bottom.
6. Click on each of the forms and complete them appropriately.
7. **PHYSICAL EXAM** form and **BIRTH CERTIFICATE** will need to be uploaded as a document or a clear picture (make sure it is the page of the physical with doctor's signature, we don't need the other pages). ***If you are not able to upload the forms, you may submit them to the school in hard copy form and we will upload them for you.***
8. Parent and student will both have to click on these links from their separate accounts because both signatures will be required before it will be approved.

If you have any questions, you may contact the Athletic Director or Athletic Trainer for the school at which you will be participating.

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TECH NOTES FROM MRS. ROY

If you have not already done so, I strongly encourage you to pay the \$25 Technology Fee for your student.

Per the HCS webpage:



Middle School Grades 6-8

All students in grades 6-8 have a Technology Fee of \$25 for the full academic year, due at the time of registration. The non-refundable fee may be paid online or in person at the appropriate school.

Students Grades 6-8 who PAY the Technology Fee:

- will use devices only at school and are not allowed to take devices home
- pay an additional \$25 for the first accidental damage repair, \$50 for the second accidental damage repair and full cost of repair for all subsequent accidental damage repairs during the academic year
- pay an additional \$25 for device replacement due to theft (requires police report)
- pay full repair for all damage caused by neglect or abuse
- pay full replacement cost for loss due to neglect

Students Grades 6-8 who DO NOT PAY the Technology Fee:

- pay full repair costs for all accidental damage
- pay full replacement cost for loss due to theft
- pay full repair for all damage caused by neglect or abuse
- pay full replacement cost for loss due to neglect

Students who do not pay the Technology Fee are responsible for the full repair costs:

- Repair/replace cracked screen--\$125
- Repair/replace broken keyboard--\$100
- Device replacement--\$365

Technology Fees can be paid through MyPaymentsPlus or at Ten Oaks Middle School.





Chronic Absenteeism



Chronically absent:

Any student in grade K-12 who misses 50 percent or more of the instructional day for any reason for 10 percent (or more) of the enrollment period.

- All types of absences contribute to chronic absenteeism:

Excused Absences

Unexcused Absences

Suspensions

- A student is absent if he or she is not physically on school grounds and is not participating in instruction or instruction-related activities at an approved off-grounds location for the school day.

Because chronic absenteeism is associated with poor academic performance, increased dropout rates and decreased graduation rates, districts and schools are encouraged to make sure that parents are aware of this change.

From Attendance Works, “National data from the Office for Civil Rights shows that at least 6.8 million public school students missed 15 or more days of school in 2013-14, and it affects at least 89 percent of the nation’s school districts. Several high quality research studies show that the impact of chronic absence leads to lower achievement, disengagement and often dropout.
