EXECUTIVE BOARD POSITIONS

2nd Vice President/Programs:

Responsible for coordinating PTSA sponsored school program, previously known as "The World of a Teen". Acts as liaison with school administration to provide support for school wide program, as well as provide opportunities to build family/school partnerships. Minimal time commitment on a monthly basis, with one already prepared program typically held in the spring.

Corresponding Secretary:

Prepares all written communication as directed by the PTSA or by the executive board and performs such other duties as may be delegated. Responsible for making sure that the meetings are conducted according to Roberts Rules of Order and for making sure the By-Laws of the National, State, County and Steinbrenner PTSA are followed. Handles all thank you notes.

COMMITTEE POSITIONS

Advocacy:

Be as creative and unique as the community you represent when coming up with ways to advocate for our students and school community.

Awards:

Submits any awards that PTSA may be eligible to receive through the County and State. Most active in the Spring.

Dad's Club:

Works as liaison with school staff for assistance with parking, locker sales, etc. Most active in the first week of school and during exams. Recruits new members and maintains member database.

Publicity:

Work with local media in getting information out about PTSA and school events.

Reflections:

Works in conjunction with the county PTA in dissemination of theme and encouragement of student's participation in the Reflections program. Ensures that all entries are submitted in a timely fashion and acts as the liaison between the school and judging officials. Most active in the Fall. Also coordinates with Art Department to display work of the winners in conjunction with the Spring semester conference night.

School of Excellence:

Responsible for enrollment and application process through PTA.org. Includes working with school administrators, teachers, students, and community members to conduct the family-school partnership scan. Set shared goals for school improvement and oversee the implementation of recommendations. This is a two-year award, last awarded 2018-2019.

Teacher/Staff Appreciation Week:

Develops school-wide PTSA appreciation program during National Teacher Week in May for entire faculty and staff.

Important AP Testing Info

AP exams are quickly approaching. It's time to start preparing for them in and out of the classroom. In addition to studying, we want to make sure students are making transportation arrangements. School times have changed this year, but AP exam times have not. Students need to report to their testing site at 7:30am for morning exams and 11:30am for noon exams. Testing sessions begin promptly at 7:45am and 11:45am. Students will not be permitted to enter once the exam has begun. Bus riders will have to find alternate transportation to and from school on their exam days. Busses will not get students to school on time for morning tests. Additionally, afternoon tests may not be done on time to permit students to catch the bus home. Everyone must keep in mind the heavy traffic situation at Steinbrenner in the mornings and plan accordingly.

AP tests are May 6-17. Students should get a good night's rest and bring necessary items to take the test: black or dark blue pens, #2 pencils, and appropriate calculators for the tests that require them. These items will not be provided. Student should bring their own snack for the break. If you have two exams on the same day, bring your lunch. You may not have time to get lunch from the cafeteria. Make sure you have transportation home if you have an afternoon test. You will most likely not be able to ride the bus.

Students should NOT bring cell phones.

Guidance News

The guidance department will provide updates on a regular basis through emails and entries on the Guidance, College & Career Edsby Group Page, and on the Steinbrenner website under "Resources" "Guidance".

April 22 deadline—Fall deadline for Dural Enrollment. See your counselor NOW to obtain a "Form B" to participate in dual enrollment in the fall.

April 17, 5-8pm—HCC Open Enrollment, Dale Mabry. Select your classes for the fall or summer. Register at https://www.hccfl.edu/hcc-enrollment-day.aspx

May 3 deadline—Seniors who have not completed the Virtual School Graduation Requirement must do so by May 3.

Bright Futures Scholarship Applications – The application opened for seniors to apply for Bright Futures and other State of Florida Scholarships at www.floridastudentfinancialaid.org. All seniors should apply and turn in community service hours if they haven't done so already. Students may continue to meet the SAT/ACT, and GPA requirements through June. Community service hours must be completed and turned in before graduation. Step by step directions have been posted to the Steinbrenner Guidance Page and to Edsby Guidance Page.

Financial Aid – Seniors and parents should be completing the financial aid process to apply for assistance in paying for college. There are several organizations that charge fees for completing the form so be sure to only use the official website – www.fafsa.ed.gov. This application allows students to obtain free money through grants, work study, and scholarships. Student may also be offered student loans through this process.

Scholarship Bulletin – Scholarship bulletins are available in the guidance office, on the school website and on the Guidance Group Page. New scholarship information will be posted as it becomes available. There are scholarship opportunities for all grade level students. Check out the local scholarships: MacDill Spouse's Club, Moffitt Healthy KIDZ Program, J.F. Swartsel and more.

The J.F. Swartsel Scholarship is exclusive to Steinbrenner students. This is a great opportunity to win a scholarship!
