#### FROM OUR PRINCIPAL

#### Dear Parents,

I hope you all had an enjoyable spring break. Following April break, the remainder of the year seems to fly by, so please be sure to read the WAG each week as there are lots of upcoming events that you wont want to miss. Keep your eyes open for volunteering opportunities at the May Fair, which will be held on May 18<sup>a</sup> and 19<sup>a</sup>.

Shortly, our teachers will begin the process of planning for next year's class placements. Careful consideration goes into preparing class lists, and vital components are considered in order to ensure that each student is placed in an appropriate educational setting.

To that end, parents are given an opportunity to express any issues or concerns regarding their child that they feel are important for the classroom teacher, and the administration to be aware of during this process. Due to the anticipated number of classroom sections for next year, there may be some teachers that will be moving to another grade level. If you feel that would impact your child's next year placement, please be sure to indicate that in your email.

#### A reminder that parents are not allowed to request individual teachers.

While many factors are taken into consideration during this process, ultimately it will be the teacher and administrator's final decision for student placement. All requests must be sent by email directly to my Administrative Assistant, Sheila and not to individual teachers, as we need to keep one central spreadsheet. Cos Cob School is pleased to announce an Earth Month partnership with the GPS Green Schools Committee and GPS Food Service Department to launch the reusable tray pilot program. On Monday students picked up for the first time the reusable red rectangular plastic food trays. The trays, lined with wax paper, provide enough space to easily hold all their food. When finished students line up and go to the newly setup recycling station, first encountering a compost station for fruits and vegetables, then moving to the liquids station where all leftover liquids were poured into buckets, recycling buckets come next and all remaining items end up in the trash.

Already there is a substantial reduction in waste at CCS. The custodians previously were emptying 5-6 trash bins and 4 recycling bins a day with 2-3 daily custodial pickups. Day one of the new program provided only 1 full trash bin and 2 full recycling bins, with only 1 custodial pickup at the end of the lunch sessions. The compost is taken outside to the recycling bins and when ready, the compost will be used in the courtyard garden.

The changes save the district money, reduce waste and improve the environment. We encourage parents to volunteer and help students learn which items can be recycled or composted to align with the Green Schools program. How much can we reduce, reuse and recycle together? Come check it out!

Hopefully this weekend we will see some sunshine and get a chance to enjoy some outside activities. Have a great weekend.


