CURRENT NEISD STUDENTS

^{*}NEISD students must have participated in the NEISD Free/Reduced Price Lunch Program during the current school year to receive the tuition discount and free transportation. Everyone must pay the \$10 non-refundable processing fee.

Method of Registration

- Students will sign in to Skyward Family Access by clicking the following link:
 https://portal.neisd.net/NEISDPortal/public#/SkywardLink/1/1045. Once logged in, click on the GLOBE icon above the student name, then "High School Summer School." Continue with your registration as prompted.
 *Note: "High School Summer School" will not be an option with Parent access. You must use the student's login to access the Summer School registration site. This easy method allows you to use your credit card (MasterCard of Visa only) April 13, 2020 at 8:00 a.m. through June 4, 2020, at 4:30 p.m.
- Full payment is due at the time of registration on the Student Portal.
- Registration for ALL students closes on June 4, 2020 at 4:30pm. There will be no on-site or late registration at Churchill HS.

HIGH SCHOOL SUMMER SCHOOL GENERAL INFORMATION

TUITION PAYMENT

Payment for tuition and fees must be made completed electronically through the Student Portal when registering for classes.

REFUNDS

The deadline to cancel an on-line registration and receive a refund, less the \$10.00 non-refundable processing fee, is June 10, 2020 at 4:30 p.m. Refunds WILL NOT be processed for students dropping classes after June 10, 2020. Refunds of payments made by credit card will be processed on-line using the original credit card information provided.

SECOND SEMESTER REGISTRATION

Students who will be enrolled for the 2nd semester only must still register by June 4, 2020.

2020-2021 CLASS SCHEDULE

Students who register on-line for a course and pass that course in summer school are not automatically registered for another course at their home campus for the 2020-2021 school year. Please contact your high school counselor after July 27, 2020, to adjust your 2020-2021 schedule.

HIGH SCHOOL SUMMER SCHOOL CURRICULUM

The high school summer school curriculum is primarily designed to remediate students who have learning gaps, and therefore, have been unsuccessful in one or more courses. Students who are planning to graduate early or to accelerate their course of study <u>may take only those courses designed for initial credit (an "F" is at the end of the course number indicating "First time a course is taken.")</u> The maximum number of credits, which may be earned in summer school, is 2.0.

SPECIAL EDUCATION

Students who are eligible for special education services should contact the campus coordinator for information.

ATTENDANCE

- NEISD summer school follows a rigorous curriculum that requires students to attend class at all times. If a
 student accumulates absences equaling more than 10% of the time the course is offered, he/she may be
 subject to loss of credit for that course with no refund of tuition. Missing more than 30 minutes of class during
 any period constitutes an absence. Students will not be excused for vacations or activities such as band
 programs, athletic camps, or other similar extracurricular activities.
- The academic intensity of the summer school program requires prompt and consistent attendance. Under the Discipline Management System of summer school, students who are persistently tardy (one to 30 minutes) to class may be dropped from attendance in summer school with no refund of tuition.

Note: 3 tardies = 1 absence

DISCIPLINE MANAGEMENT

Students attending summer school sessions within NEISD are held responsible for following the District Student Code of Conduct. Attendance and Discipline are two reasons students may be removed from the summer school program. Students who engage in serious misconduct will be referred to the Office of Pupil Personnel for additional consequences. See the online Student/Parent Handbook at www.neisd.net/pupil/studenthb.html.
