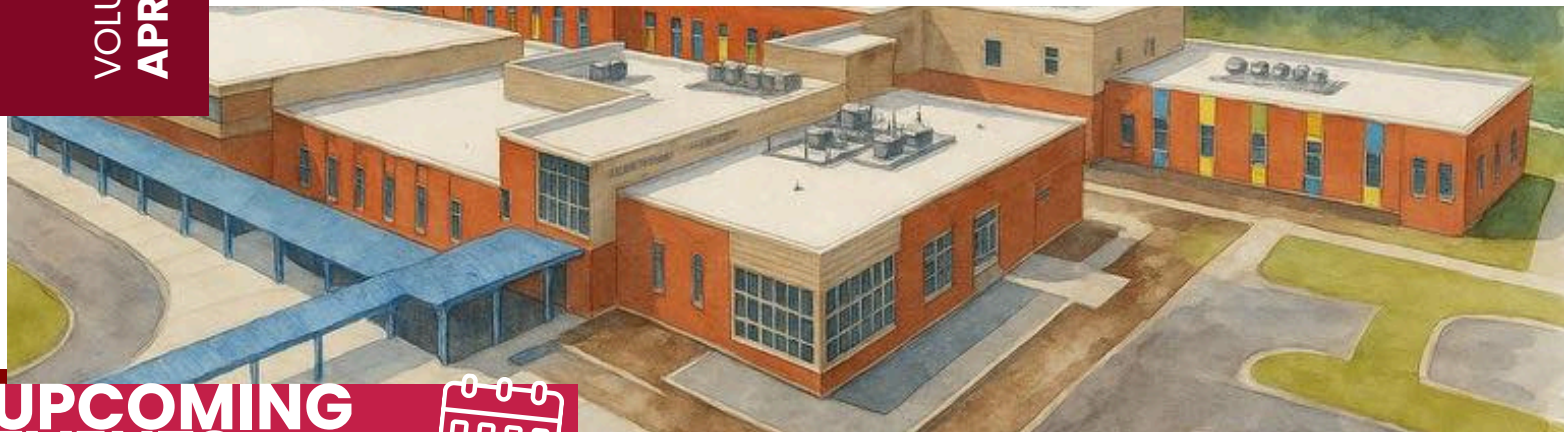

State testing is coming to all students in grades 3-5. Testing is required. It is untimed and will take several hours. Please do not schedule doctor appointments and out of school functions during testing hours. Students may not be in possession of any electronic devices that can be used for communicating, timing, creating images, or storing images. This includes cellphones and smart watches. Please make sure that your child is getting a good night of sleep and eating a nutritious breakfast. Testing will begin promptly at 8 am.
