

This Week's Character Challenge: What kind things have you done this week? Students will write any acts of kindness they have done to celebrate all of the kind things that are happening at Bryant Elementary.

Today, we kicked off our character trait of Kindness. While we have featured kindness this school year, we felt it was important for students to gain opportunities to hone the skills needed to develop these character traits.
