Lunch with your Fielder Falcon Reminder

Parents and guardians are welcome to come to lunch with their students. Please be mindful of these guidelines:

- 1. All visitors must ENTER and EXIT through the front office. All visitors must have an ID. (Driver's License, Passport, VISA, and state ID) 'Raptor' badges must be worn while on campus.
- 2. Due to space constraints, please limit lunch visits to 2 per week. Max three (3) people per student during a lunch. This includes infants, toddlers, etc. No strollers are allowed in the cafeteria. Please use the designated stroller parking located outside the cafeteria.
- 3. Only Parents/Guardians and Grandparents are allowed to eat lunch/visit students during lunch. Grandparents need WRITTEN permission from the parent/guardian to eat with your Falcon. Please send an email to fe@katyisd.org stating the student's name and grandparent's name.
- 4. You and your Falcon will eat at the guest tables in the cafeteria, not at the classroom table. You are more than welcome to bring in a special meal, but do not share with any other student. You will only be allowed to sit with your student, please do not include any classroom friends.
- 5. No school aged children (from any other school or home school) will be allowed in the cafeteria.
