- 1. Park in the designated area in the parking lot located at the front of the school.
- Check-in at the front office. Your identification is required every time you volunteer at the school. The front office staff will swipe your id and provide you with a badge.
- 3. The badge must always be worn and visible while you are at the school.
- 4. On your way out, return your badge to the front office staff so you can be signed out.
