Important Information/Change: With the addition of approximately 100 students next school year, we will no longer be able to allow cars to enter the front or side parking lots during arrival or dismissal. All cars will need to use the car rider line. Please go ahead and start practicing this so that it will become routine before next year. In the new school year if you need to drop off cupcakes, enter the office for a change of transportation, or other delivery, etc. you will be able to enter the front parking lot to enter the building. However, parents wishing to avoid the car rider line or wanting to walk their student to the front door will be directed to the car rider line. This has been allowed this year due to our small number but as we grow it becomes a safety concern. We will also adjust biker/walker routes onto campus to ensure safety—these details will be released next week. Thank you for understanding and for helping ensure safety for all.


