Have your heard your student talk about Bengal Bucks? Are you wondering about Bengal Bucks? Bengal Bucks are part of our school-wide Positive Behavior Intervention and Supports (PBIS) system. Students earn Bengal Bucks from their teacher and other staff members, then use their bucks to cash in for a variety of prizes—from hat passes to slime or lunch with the principal, there are a variety of rewards to choose from. Each reward is worth a different amount so students can choose a reward at 15 Bengal Bucks, 20 Bengal bucks, or save their bucks for the higher rewards which cost 50 Bengal Bucks. While students are rewarded for positive behavior they also learn about making choices with their bucks, saving their bucks, and many other skills. Ask your kids today how many Bengal Bucks they have saved since the beginning of the year!!
