We also want you to be aware of the New AP (Advanced Placement for College Board) Registration process for the 2019-2020 school year. College Board has made some exciting changes in the resources that will be available to students and teachers. Please take a moment to review the linked information regarding these enhancements. Along with the change to resources, it is necessary to increase the cost of Non-Free/Reduced rate to \$40 and Free/Reduced rate to \$20 per exam fee. In addition, College Board is implementing an early fall deadline for exam registration and exam fee collection. Therefore, the North East deadline for this registration and collection process will be **October 24, 2019** for the 2020 AP exams. In order to make this a smooth transition period, we are asking that students create a College Board Student Account if they do not already have one.
